Dear Parents of Rising Grade II Students,

Your children have worked hard this year and made significant progress in reading. Summer should be relaxing and fun with less structure and more time to unwind. We are hoping that daily reading can be part of that. We want to encourage you to monitor their reading this summer so that they continue the habit of reading “just right” books everyday (minimally five days a week).

At the end of the school year, your child’s classroom teacher sent home a “Reading Log,” your child’s reading goals and list of recommended books (as well as suggested summer math work) in a bright green folder. **Please be sure that your child records the books that he/she reads.** Encourage your child to star favorite books. The log can also be downloaded from the Grade Level Requirements Box (Entering Grade 2) on the Library webpage (http://www.parkschoolcommunity.net/summer_reading). **Children should bring their summer reading logs back to school when they return in the fall.** In September, we will have a summer reading celebration.
